Old Business

- Blossom Festival Sandy Goff presented the breakdown of expenses and revenue to the council and the Mayor expressed his appreciation for all who helped and it was a big success for the children.
- Bank Loan: Sandy Goff stated that the loan at First Southern Bank is in process.
- Dumpster: The City will have their annual Spring cleaning starting May 5th and it will be published May 3rd for the citizens of Drakesboro to use.
- Community Center: The duct work has been fixed.
- Lawn Mower: The City did purchase a BadBoy lawn mower from four seasons as the council had voted on.
- PSC: The Mayor updated the council on everything the PSC is wanting the City to do and what the plans were to comply.

New Business:

 May's council meeting will have to be changed to May 9th due to the election on the 17th and the Community Center will not be available 16th-18th. The council was fine with this.

- The Mayor stated that the emergency sirens were still not working and that he spoke with someone to ask the county emergency management to get it fixed asap. He will also ask that the siren, when fixed, to be tested daily at noon.. The council supported this idea.
- Tex Allen made a motion to allow one city water customer to be rewarded every month with \$25.00 credit to their bill if they receive a golden ticket on the back of their water bill. They will have to come in and present it to the clerk to receive the credit to their water bill. Scott Newman seconded the Motion. Motion passed.
- Larry Shrodes made a motion for the Mayor of Drakesboro to receive \$300.00 a week as salary for the Mayor's position. Scott Newman seconded the motion. None opposed. Motion passed.
- Larry Shrodes made the motion that the council and mayor receive \$750.00 yearly for council meetings. Scott Newman seconded this motion. None opposed. Motion passed

- Scott Newman made a motion to adjourn and Tex Allen seconded the motion. Motion passed.
