

ORDINANCE

The city council of the city of Drakesboro, Ky. do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1:

8
Red Light
That as a measure to protect life and property in the city of Drakesboro, it shall be necessary, and is hereby ordered, to place one electric traffic signal at the intersection of Main street and state high-way.

SECTION 2:

This light is automatic and is electrically controlled, with red light with the wording stop, signyfing danger, and meaning stop, and with green light with wording go, indicating the way clear and meaning go. These lights change at intervells of approximately 28 seconds clearing right of way at each change in one direction only.

SECTION: 3

That it shall be unlawful for any person or person firms or incorporations to drive, or cause to be driven, ^{ANY VEHICLE} against the red light and wording stop, excepting what is known as right hand turns, which may be made slowly and cautiously.

SECTION 4

Each person firm or incorporation violating the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction be fined not less than five (\$5.00) dollars nor more than (\$10.00) ten dollars.

Section 5: All ordinances or parts of ordinances that conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
