

AN ORDINANCE

Pin Ball
An Ordinance imposing a license fee on all pin ball machines, subject to Kentucky State Laws, Rules and Regulations.

The City Council of the City of Drakesboro, Kentucky, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. That all person, persons, firm, corporations, etc., owning or operating or permitting to operate for amusement only, any pin ball machines or any machine classed as pin ball machine, shall procure a license from the City Clerk.

SECTION 2. That a license fee shall be assessed and collected as follows; \$5.00 shall be collected yearly on each machine and no license shall be issued for less than one year. Each machine shall constitute a seperate machine and the removal of one shall not permit another to operate without a seperate license.

SECTION 3. Any person, persons, firms, corporations, etc., violating any provision of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$10.00 for each offense.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and being posted according to law.
