ORIDINANCE NO. 03-01-23

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO ABATEMENT OF NUISANCES PERTAINING LOTS AND YARDS IN THE CITY LIMITS OF DRAKESBORO, KY NOT INCLUDING WOODED ACRES

Part A Reasons

- 1. To make the city a safe place to live.
- 2. For the health and welfare of the citizens.
- 3. For the appearance of the city.

Part B Violations

- Yards and lots not being cleaned, or full of clutter including, but not limited to the
 presence of any accumulation of filth, garbage, toys, cardboard boxes, household
 appliances/furniture, vegetation overgrowth, litter, trash, unsanitary, debris, waste
 material, animal or human excrement is a nuisance prohibited under law. Likewise,
 overgrown, dead, or decayed trees, weeds or other vegetation, rubbish, junk, garbage,
 litter, debris, are recognized as a fire hazards and conditions that promote the spread of
 vermin.
- 2. Yards and lots not kept mowed.
- 3. No burned houses and buildings.
- 4. Lots with abandoned houses and buildings.
- 5. Condemned houses and buildings.
- 6. Any conditions that could affect the health and welfare of the citizens.

Part C Enforcement

- 1. The mayor is the enforcer.
- 2. The mayor is to answer all complaints and to patrol the city streets frequently to observe for violations.
- 3. Any complaints need to be made in writing form to the Drakesboro City office from the citizens of Drakesboro, and City Council members.

Part D Notification

- 1. On a violation the mayor is to notify owner in writing form with a copy of the ordinance of the violation he/she has and is given 30 days to correct violation.
- 2. If violation is not corrected to the satisfaction of the mayor, there will be a \$500 fine, every 30 days until the violation is corrected, and legal actions will be taken.
- 3. There will be a lien placed on property and filed at the Muhlenberg County Court House.
- 4. All violations will be kept on file and a set will be presented to the council members.
- 5. There will be no work or city equipment, or employees used to correct violations.

Part E Effective Date of Ordinance Provisions

The Ordinance shall take effect immediately after its Passage and Publications as required by law.
