CITY OF DRAKESBORO, KENTUCKY ORDINANCE NO. 98-01

ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE POSITION OF CHIEF OF POLICE

WHEREAS, the City of Drakesboro, a fifth class city, desires to establish the nonelective position of Chief of Police.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DRAKESBORO:

- Section 1. The nonelective position of Chief of Police is hereby established effective January 31, 1998.
- Section 2. The Chief of Police shall be appointed by the Mayor and may be removed by the Mayor, as set forth in KRS 83A.130(9).
- Section 3. The Chief of Police shall take the oath required of public officers as set forth in Section 228 of the Kentucky Constitution.
- Section 4. The Chief of Police shall post a bond as required by law and with good and adequate security, which bond shall be approved by the Mayor.
- Section 5. The Chief of Police shall be compensated as per the pay schedule established by the City. The compensation of the Chief of Police shall be subject to adjustment from time-to-time on at least an annual basis.
- Section 6. The Chief of Police of the City of Drakesboro shall have all of the powers and authorities granted to police officers in a city of the fifth class by the Kentucky Revised Statutes, including the power to make arrests and carry deadly weapons.
- Section 7. This ordinance shall become effective immediately.
- Section 8. All other ordinances and orders of the City in conflict herewith are hereby rescinded.
