AN ORDINACE TO PROHIBIT PROPERTY OWNERS IN THE CITY OF DRAKESBORO KEN TUCKY, TO ALLOW WEEDS OR GRASS TO STAND ON THEIR PREMISES WITHOUT BEING MOWED.

Section 1 For sanitary reasons the city council of the city of Drakesboro do ardain as follows: that is shall be unlawful for any person, or persons firm or corporation to allow weeds or grass to stand on their premises without being mowed.

Section 11 That all persons firms corporations who reside in or out of the city of Drakesboro, and hold title, or titles to any lot or lots shall mow or cause to be mowed, any weeds, or grass that has grown or may grow upon any and all of their premises. All weeds shall be mowed when they shall have grown to a height that they may be mowed eaisly, and before the odor from such weeds or grass may become offensive.

Each person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction be fined not less than five (\$5.00) Dollars, nor more than twenty five (\$25.00) Dollars.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor and publication as required by law.
