

ORDINANCE 80- /

WHEREAS, the City of Drakesboro has determined that it is in the public interest to install and establish a sanitary sewer system within the City of Drakesboro, Kentucky;

WHEREAS, funds are being obtained for the installation of the said system which is for municipal purposes and which is in the public interest;

WHEREAS, in order to install the sewer lines it is necessary to obtain easements across the private property in the City of Drakesboro by easement or through condemnation under the Eminent Domain Act of Kentucky, KRS Chapter 416 and as authorized by KRS Chapter 87 and all other applicable authority;

WHEREAS, some property owners in the City of Drakesboro refuse to give easements across their property, or the compensation therefore cannot be agreed upon, or the whereabouts of the owners of the property are unknown;

NOW, THEREFORE,

The City Council of the City of Drakesboro, Kentucky, does ordain follows:

1. The Mayor of the City of Drakesboro, Kentucky, is hereby directed to attempt through its attorney, to acquire easements across all properties in the City of Drakesboro where it is necessary to lay sewer lines and appurtenances thereto necessary or appertaining thereto and if the compensation therefore cannot be agreed upon or if the whereabouts of the owner of the property cannot be determined to proceed to condemn the right to cross the property under the provisions of and in the manner provided in the Eminent Domain Act

of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

2. The Mayor is further directed to publish this Ordinance in an accordance with the applicable Statutes.

3. This Ordinance shall be effective from the date of its enactment and publication.
